

# The Italic Script for the Beginner

Italic script developed during the Renaissance in Italy and is an easy script to learn for beginners. It is popular for use with quotations, wedding invitations, art calligraphy and improving handwriting style.

Mark and Lee will guide you through the basic lower and upper case letters, numerals and punctuation. Depending on your skill level, individual attention will steer you to the next level of pen manipulation and flourishing your letters.

Class projects will use this beautiful script to address envelopes and designing name tags.
